Vape Takeback for Retail Chains: One Account, One Invoice

Each store gets a one-off setup: bins, the required signage, a logbook and training for the area manager. Then one flat all-in price per collection when a bin is full, with stores in the same area routed together on one run. **No monthly fees. No per-kilo meters. You only pay when something happens.**

YOUR DUTIES TODAY

- **In-store takeback** of waste vapes in every store selling them (WEEE category 7.1, SI 2025/910), with visible customer signage
- **Safe storage:** returned vapes are lithium-bearing hazardous waste, segregated with a damaged-device escalation route
- **Documented onward movement:** a hazardous waste consignment note for every collection, records kept at least four years
- **Consistency across the estate:** one store's gap is an oversight, the same gap in every store is a pattern

WHAT IS CHANGING, AND WHEN

- MAY 2026** **Tobacco & Vapes Act** in force: government can require a licence to sell vapes, evidence expected per store
- 12 AUG 2026** **Producers fund collection & treatment** (SI 2025/910). Collection prices are falling: legacy per-kg and per-visit contracts are probably overpaying
- OCT 2026** **Digital waste tracking** reaches permitted waste-receiving sites, extending to carriers and brokers from October 2027

How Chains Pay: Set Up Once, Then a Flat Price Per Collection

One-off setup

PAID ONCE

One-off fee quoted for your estate

Pay once per store, set up properly

- Two-bin kit: tube and UN-approved drum
- Required in-store signage
- Simple logbook and staff SOP
- Training session for the area manager

Flat-price collections

ONLY WHEN FULL

One flat price per collection

Carrier, note and records included

- ADR carrier, consignment note on the day
- Every collection logged and filed per store
- Same-area stores routed on one run
- Never per kilo, nothing in between
- One account, one invoice, dashboard and named contact

OPTIONAL ADD-ON • COMPLIANCE COVER, PER STORE PER MONTH

Store 1	Plan rate: £29 / £49
Stores 2–5	£25
Stores 6–15	£15
Stores 16–30	£10
Whole-account cap	£299 / £349 per mo

Logbooks maintained, virtual staff training, signage kept current, paperwork managed. Billed annually by default. All prices + VAT. Optional, never required.

THE SHORT VERSION Two numbers, quoted once for the estate: a per-store setup fee and a flat all-in price per collection. A quiet store costs nothing between collections. Optional Essentials cover for a 24-store estate is about £300 a month.

- 04 Routes and consignment notes go live;** the chain layer switches on
